



Maryland Outstanding 4-H Club Award

Due: May 1st of the current year

A special award can be given to the one most outstanding 4-H club in each of the local 4-H units*, 4-H Army Korea and Europe Regions.

1. Every year a local 4-H unit, 4-H Army Korea and Europe (one per country) may nominate their most outstanding 4-H club. The total club program should be considered in selecting the one most outstanding club. The “Maryland 4-H Club Recognition Plan” **may** be used as a guide to making this selection. Other criteria established by 4-H Extension Educators, program staff, and/or volunteers that take the entire club program into consideration may also be used in selecting the most outstanding club.
2. Participating Units, Army Korea and Europe regions should submit a request for an “Outstanding 4-H Club” award to the Maryland 4-H Office.
3. Clubs may not win the award two years in succession.
